

What is SinoSummer?

- Sino-Summer is an affordable, authentic and focused short-term-study-in-China experience.
- Students chose from two Sino-Summer sessions to study in either Nanjing or Guiyang, and live there on campus for a month, while earning BSU credits.
- During the Spring session, you will attend pre-trip orientation (INTL 2100 Instructed International Tour) before flying out to China in May.
- Accommodations and tuition at Chinese Universities are covered by scholarships, and a monthly stipend will cover student meals from the host institutions.
- Eligibility: Having completed 2 semester at BSU by the time of travel and GPA > 2.5.

15 affiliated hospitals and 3 pharmaceutical companies, Co-faculty is housed in the acupuncture training center




Nanjing: Destination Profile

Undergraduate programs across over 40 colleges, 76 graduate programs and 20 doctoral programs.




Nine campuses, with 34,000 undergraduate students, and 13,000 graduate students, including international students. BSU students will stay on West Campus.
